Each year the Lions Foundation of West Comal County grants scholarships to graduating high school seniors. The number and amount of the awards varies each year. For the 2016 – 2017 graduating class two \$1000 scholarships are available.

The scholarships are intended to help high school seniors with their post-secondary study at a college, university, or trade school. Awards are given to students via a deposit made to the respective student's account at the attended institution; thereafter, the funds may be used for any expenses connected with attending the chosen institution.

The scholarship selection committee selects only from applications and winners are determined by the criteria listed below.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

Graduating seniors from SVHS, Bracken, Living Rock and Home Schooled pursuing a post-secondary education.

SUBMISSION / AWARD INFORMATION

No late applications will be accepted.

Please DO NOT include high school transcripts.

If you attend Smithson Valley High School: all submissions MUST be made through your guidance counselor. The application form must be signed and given to your counselor no later than 20 February 2016.

- General application merit (grammar usage, organization, style, originality, vocabulary)
